HALL OF FAME

CRITERIA

HALL OF FAME NOMINATION

Nominations will be called upon each year for consideration by the Board for inclusion into the Darts Australia Hall of Fame. There are two forms of nomination

1) Sporting Nomination and 2) Administration. Only one nominee shall be selected each year for induction into the Hall of Fame.

Nomination Categories

Sport – Player Nomination

To nominate a player for the Sport – Player Nomination, the nominee must:-

- Have achieved high levels of performance at national and/or international standard, and served Darts Australia as a sporting ambassador of the highest order.

Sport – Administration Nomination

To nominate for the Sport - Administration Nomination, the nominee must:-

- Have contributed to the advancement of the sport of darts in some form through administrative and/or officiating activities.
- Have been acknowledged by players and active members as making a fair contribution to the betterment of the sport during their time of engagement.

Selection Committee

The neutral Selection Committee, of three, nominated by the Board and chaired by the President, or delegated person nominated by the Board, will consider the degree of difficulty for a nominee to attain the highest level of achievement.

The Selection Committee may consider a nominee's individual record, ability, integrity, sportsmanship and character.

The Selection Committee to assess and rank the nominations in order of merit and provide the assessment details of each nominee to the Board to consider at the Feb/March General Meeting.

Nominator

Any active member may make nominations for consideration by the Selection Committee.

Unsuccessful Nominations

Any unsuccessful member will be automatic nominations for the following year.

Nomination Date

Nominations are to be provided to the DA Secretary six weeks prior to the Feb/Mar (Midyear) General Meeting.

INDUCTION

Induction into the Hall of Fame to occur at the Australian Championships, Closing Function, and a plaque to be presented to the inductee.

ROLL OF HONOUR

Names of inductees are to be displayed on a Roll of Honour.
